The Accountability Committee (Committee) of The North Carolina Partnership for Children (NCPC) Board of Directors (Board) met on May 20, 2025 via Zoom video conferencing. Vice Chair Simpkin called the meeting to order. The presence of a quorum was established.

Approval of Agenda

Smart Start Accountability Plan

Annually, the Accountability Committee and Finance and Audit Committee review the Smart Start Accountability Plan. No edits recommended from the Strategy Division. Joe Brownlee provided a summary of the minor revisions, from the Finance Division, in the body of the document.

A motion was made by Page Lemel and seconded to recommend approval of the changes to clarify the language in item 6a of the Accountability Plan to the Board at its June 17, 2025 meeting.

Explore Shifts in NCPC Data System

Casey Strange provided a demonstration of the new contract data management system (CDMS) and answered questions. The new system will allow local partnerships to collect individual data, not just aggregate. The system will begin collecting outcome data for each Smart Solution. There are several learning opportunities for local partnerships to implement new data collection reporting. The training schedule is built out to provide multiple modalities for technical assistance.

Local partnerships understand the need for accurate data that tells the stories of program impact. Additional data is helpful for program assessment and planning purposes. Some funders have also asked for additional data.
