Expand Public-Private Partnerships

Invest in Tri-Share Administrative Technology

The **NC Tri-Share Child Care Program** is a vital initiative where employers, employees, and the state collaboratively share child care costs, directly addressing a critical cause of workforce departure for families with children five and under—a lack of affordable child care. Affordable care drives a staggering 26% of parents with children five and under out of the workforce.

To effectively scale and sustain this program, an **upfront investment of approximately \$200,000 in administrative technology is essential to develop a streamlined digital platform.** This system would streamline key functions such as employer and provider enrollment, tracking contributions, facilitating timely provider payments, and simplifying employee/family applications and eligibility determination.

Transitioning from a labor-intensive process to a more automated and efficient system will reduce administrative burden, enhance transparency, and allow regional hubs to dedicate more time to recruitment, ultimately ensuring the program's growth and broader reach across NC.
