

# Join the NC Tri-Share Child Care Program

## Help offset the cost of child care

The NC Tri-Share Child Care Program is a public-private partnership to share the cost of child care among employers, eligible employees, and the State, each covering an equal share. This initiative provides child care benefits to eligible employees, supporting working families.


### Colleague Eligibility Requirements:

- ✓ Receive payroll from your participating employer.
- ✓ Have a child under 12 enrolled in a licensed child care provider in the state of North Carolina.
- ✓ Meet the Eligibility Household Income Levels (see below).

To qualify, employees must have a **household income between 185%-300%** of the Federal Poverty Level and be otherwise ineligible for other subsidized child care. Levels are calculated each year.

Household Size	Yearly Income (185%-300% of federal poverty level)
Two Person	\$40,034 – \$64,920
Three Person	\$50,542 – \$81,960
Four Person	\$61,050 – \$99,000
Five Person	\$71,558 – \$116,040
Six Person	\$82,066 – \$133,080
Seven Person	\$92,574 – \$150,120
Eight Person	\$103,082 – \$167,160

## Price of Child Care Shared Three Ways



### Process to Participate in NC Tri-Share

- ✓ Employee submits application to receive 2/3 of the price of child care.
- ✓ Employee receives a secure link to upload federal tax forms.
- ✓ Employee receives notification of status of application, indicating whether it has been approved or denied.
- ✓ Upon approval, employee and employer agrees to pay 9% administration fee on their 1/3 cost of child care.
